*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 26 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws most recently  
2 amended by Chapter 554 of the Acts of 1979 is hereby amend-

5 any other law a son or daughter of a police officer who passes  
6 the required written and physical examination for entrance to  
7 the police service shall if such police officer was retired from  
8 said police service because of injuries received in the per-  
9 formance of duty under the provisions of a special act shall  
10 have his or her name placed in the first position of the eligible  
11 list for appointment to such police service after those eligibles  
12 as set forth under Chapter 554 of the Acts of 1979.
