6 and 1982 House documents numbered 830, legislation relative
7 to the utilization of electric subtransmission, transmission, and
8 distribution facilities and equipment for cities and towns hav-
9 ing municipal electric departments; 2256, legislation regulating
10 the fuel charges of electric utility companies; 5866, legislation
11 relative to the licensing of certain auctioneers; and 5895, legis-
12 lation relative to clarifying the fuel charge act of 1981, be re-
13 vived and continued.
