**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN APPOINTMENTS TO PERMANENT
FULL-TIME POSITIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 20D the following section: —

3 *Section 20E.* Any person who is employed in a position on
4 a full-time basis after passing an examination for such posi-
5 tion shall, upon the expiration of four years of continuous
6 service in such position be appointed on a permanent full-
7 time basis in such position.
