AN ACT FURTHER SPECIFYING THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR PROPERTY
TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause seventeen of Section 5 of Chapter 59, as most re-
2 cently amended by Chapter 580 of the Acts and Resolves of
3 1978, is further amended by adding the following words to
4 the end of the first sentence: — ; and provided further that
5 an exemption shall not be denied in the event that any sub-
6 sequent marriage of said surviving spouse is void, annulled
7 or ends in death or divorce.

The Constitution of the State

SECTION 1. The State shall be a free and independent State, and shall have the right to alter, amend or abolish its Constitution as it may think proper.

SECTION 2. The Legislature shall have the power to pass bills for the following purposes:

(1) To provide for the support of the Executive, Judicial and other departments of the State.

(2) To provide for the support of the State Government.

(3) To provide for the support of the State Militia.

(4) To provide for the support of the State Police.

(5) To provide for the support of the State Prison.
