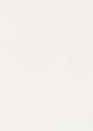

**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A LIMIT TO THE TAXATION OF THE
WHOLESALE PRICE OF GASOLINE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of revenue is hereby prohibited
2 from increasing the tax on the wholesale price of gasoline
3 more than ten cents.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first,
2 nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
