AN ACT INCREASING THE PAYMENTS BY THE CITY OF WORCESTER AND THE TOWN OF LEICESTER FOR WATER SUPPLY AND AIRPORT LANDS IN THE TOWN OF PAXTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of any general or
- 2 special law, the city of Worcester and the town of Leicester
- 3 shall pay annually to the town of Paxton an amount equal to
- 4 the amount which would be assessable on the fair market
- 5 value of the water supply and airport lands held by the city
- 6 of Worcester and the town of Leicester in the town of Paxton.
