AN ACT EXEMPTING FARMER-WINERY LICENSES FROM TRANSPORTATION PERMIT REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 22 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 261 of the acts of 1981, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting after the seventh paragraph the  
4 following paragraph: —

5 Farmer-Winery Licenses, or any individual, partnership,  
6 corporation, or any general express or trucking or other trans-  
7 portation or delivery entity, transporting or delivering the  
8 products of Farmer-Winery Licenses, are exempt from the  
9 requirements of any permits or the fees therefor required by  
10 this section as to such transportation or delivery of said prod-  
11 ucts.
