**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO LEASE CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF DEDHAM TO THE DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS POST NUMBER FORTY-TWO.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any special or General Law to the con-  
2 trary, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority is  
3 hereby authorized and directed to lease certain land owned by  
4 said authority in the town of Dedham totaling two and one-  
5 quarter acres. Said land is bounded by the New York, New  
6 Haven and Hartford Railroad, West Roxbury branch line  
7 right of way, on East street at the intersection of High street  
8 in said town, as shown on a plan held by the Massachusetts  
9 Bay Transportation Authority shown as Map #109, plot 25,  
10 359 East street at High street containing 104,255 square feet,  
11 more or less. One and one-half acres of said land shall be  
12 leased for a period of ninety-nine years. If said land is not  
13 used for the purposes of a veterans' post it shall revert to the  
14 commonwealth.
