AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DECREASE BY INTERCHANGE OF SUBSIDIARY ACCOUNTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 29 of Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding to the first sentence the following new
3 language: —

4 and, provided further that no interchange out of the sub-
5 sidiary account entitled "01 salaries, Permanent Positions"
6 to the accounts entitled "03 Contracted Employees Salaries"
7 and "07 laboratory and medical supplies and expenses" for
8 the purpose of contracting out services currently provided by
9 state employees shall be approved.
