AN ACT RELATIVE TO PURCHASES OF ELECTRICITY BY THE HULL
MUNICIPAL LIGHT PLANT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law, rule or regulation to the contrary, any new contract to
3 be entered into by the town of Hull or the Hull municipal light
4 plant involving the purchase of shares of generating capacity
5 or of electric power facilities shall require, to be effective and
6 binding, the approval by a majority vote of those voting on a
7 referendum conducted by ballot at a special or annual election.
