AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER OF BARNSTABLE COUNTY TO  
PAY CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, the treasurer of Barnstable County is hereby au-  
3 thorized, with the approval of the county commissioners, to  
4 expend the sum of two hundred and twenty-three dollars and  
5 thirty-seven cents for the purpose of making a payment to  
6 Michael J. Princi, Esq., and Group Insurance Commission,  
7 from any available funds, including federal revenue sharing  
8 funds, in the treasury of the county, for work done for the  
9 Commonwealth, county of Barnstable, during the fiscal years,  
10 1978 through 1981.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provision of the tenth par-  
2 agraph of section thirty-two of chapter thirty-five of the Gen-  
3 eral Laws, bills included in excess of one year may be paid.
