AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NAUSET REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF UNION 54 SCHOOL DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general  
2 or special law to the contrary, the Nauset Regional School Dis-  
3 trict Committee may include in its annual operating budget  
4 such administration costs for which expenditures would other-  
5 wise be prorated and paid by the member towns in the Union  
6 54 School District.

1 SECTION 2. The treasurer of the Nauset Regional School Dis-  
2 trict is hereby authorized to pay the liabilities incurred under  
3 the provisions of Section 1. After such payment, said treas-  
4 urer shall bill each member town of the Union 54 School Dis-  
5 trict for its pro rata share. Such reimbursements received by  
6 said treasurer from the member towns shall be credited to the  
7 estimated receipts account.

1 SECTION 3. Any action taken pursuant to the provisions of  
2 this act is hereby validated and effective as though this act  
3 were in effect on January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-  
4 three.
