AN ACT ADDING CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF AVON TO THE LIST OF PERMANENT INTERMITTENT POLICE OFFICERS FOR SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
