## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROCKTON TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF AND TO PAY A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The city of Brockton is hereby authorized to appropriate  
2 money for the payment of, and after such appropriation, the  
3 treasurer of said city is hereby authorized to pay Bertarelli  
4 Brothers, Inc., three thousand five hundred and eighty dol-  
5 lars and seventy-five cents for services rendered to the city of  
6 Brockton during the fiscal year nineteen hundred and eighty-  
7 two.
