AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF DENTISTRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 43 of chapter 112 of the general laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 757 of the acts of 1977, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the following sentence —
4 “Four members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the
5 transaction of business.” and inserting in its place the follow-
6 ing new sentence — “Five members of the board shall con-
7 stitute a quorum for the transaction of business.”
