
By Ms. Melconian, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1913) of Linda J. Melconian for legislation to provide for the appointment of the treasurer and the collector of taxes of the town of Worthington by the board of selectmen of said town. Local Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TREASURER AND THE COLLECTOR OF TAXES OF THE TOWN OF WORTHINGTON BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the treasurer of the town of Worth-
3 ington shall be appointed for a three year term by the board
4 of selectmen of said town, and the person so appointed shall
5 have all the powers and duties by law vested in the office of
6 treasurer. Upon the qualification and appointment of the
7 treasurer pursuant to the authority contained in this act, the
8 elected incumbent of the office of treasurer of said town shall
9 cease to exercise the powers and duties of said office. Said
10 town may establish by bylaw such qualifications for said of-
11 fice as deemed necessary and appropriate. Any vacancy in
12 such office shall be filled in like manner for the unexpired por-
13 tion of the term.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 or special law to the contrary, the collector of taxes of the
3 town of Worthington shall be appointed for a three year term
4 by the board of selectmen of said town, and the person so ap-
5 pointed shall have all the powers and duties by law vested in
6 the office of collector of taxes. Upon the qualification and ap-
7 pointment of the collector of taxes pursuant to the authority
8 contained in this act, the incumbent of the office of collector
9 of taxes shall cease to exercise the powers and duties of said
10 office. Said town may establish by bylaw such qualifications

11 for said office as deemed necessary and appropriate. Any
12 vacancy in such office shall be filled in like manner for the
13 unexpired portion of the term.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on May first, nineteen
2 hundred and eighty-three.
