### AN ACT REGULATING THE LABELING AND SALE OF MAPLE SYRUP.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 36C of Chapter 128 of the General Laws,  
2 as inserted by Chapter 103 of the Acts of 1982, is hereby  
3 amended by inserting in the first sentence thereof, before the  
4 words “‘maple syrup’”, the word: — “‘maple’”.

1 SECTION 2. Said Section 36C is hereby further amended by  
2 inserting in the second sentence thereof, before the words  
3 “‘maple syrup’”, the word: — “‘maple’”.

1 SECTION 3. Said Section 36C is hereby further amended by  
2 inserting in the third sentence thereof, before the words  
3 “‘maple syrup’”, the words: — “‘maple’ or”.
