AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF GREAT BARRINGTON TO EXTEND THE EFFECTIVE DATES OF SEASONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven-
2 teen of chapter one hundred thirty-eight of the General Laws,
3 the licensing authority of the town of Great Barrington may
4 extend the effective dates of licenses issued under section
5 fifteen of said chapter one hundred thirty-eight to be effective
6 from April the first to January the fifteenth of the following
7 year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
