Sullivan (by vote of the town) for legislation to exempt the positions of secretaries and clerks in the office of the town clerk and accountant of the town of Norwood from the provisions of the civil service law. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITIONS OF SECRETARIES AND CLERKS IN THE OFFICE OF THE TOWN CLERK AND ACCOUNTANT OF THE TOWN OF NORWOOD FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The positions of secretary and clerk in the Of-
2 fice of the Town Clerk and Accountant of the Town of Nor-
3 wood shall not be subject to the provisions of Chapter 31 of
4 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section 1 shall not impair the
2 civil service status of any person employed in the position of
3 secretary or clerk in the Office of the Town Clerk and Ac-
4 countant of the Town of Norwood on the effective date of
5 this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
