## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER INTERSTATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 495 IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON AS THE HONORABLE RUDOLPH H. DE SILVA MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The bridge on interstate highway route 495 over  
2 Bay Street in the city of Taunton shall be designated and  
3 known as the Honorable Rudolph H. DeSilva Memorial bridge,  
4 in memory of the former prisoner of war and former mayor  
5 of Taunton.

6 Suitable markers bearing said designation shall be at-  
7 tached thereto by the department of public works in com-  
8 pliance with the standards of said department and as author-  
9 ized by the Federal Highway Administration.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
