Bertonazzi for legislation to increase consumer participation in proceedings affecting medical service corporations and hospital service corporations; the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 868) of Francis D. Doris for legislation to require that homeowner insurance rates be uniform throughout the Commonwealth; the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 883) of David H. Locke for legislation to require notice to employees prior to cancellation of group insurance; the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 893) of Allan R. McKinnon for legislation to provide insurance discounts for motor vehicles equipped with speed regulatory devices; the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 903) of Martin T. Reilly and Denis L. McKenna for legislation to require home care services to be included in group health insurance policies, employees health and welfare funds, group hospital service contracts and group medical service contracts; and the petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1170) of Peter C. Webber for legislation to establish a municipal liability insurance fund, reports the accompanying order (Senate, No. 2071).
