By Mr. Olver, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2084) of John W. Olver and William D. Benson for legislation to authorize Maria G. Gusan to take a civil service examination for police officer notwithstanding the maximum age requirements. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING MARIA G. GUSAN TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 or special law or rule to the contrary regulating the maximum
3 age of applicants for appointment as a police officer, Marie G.
4 Gusan of the town of Greenfield shall be eligible to take the
5 next open competitive entrance exam for police officers, and
6 provided she meets all other requirements, shall be eligible
7 for certification and appointment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
