RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE NEEDS OF THE HISPANIC POPULATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study relative to the needs of the Hispanic popula-
6 tion in the commonwealth, including, but not limited to, em-
7 ployment, education, housing, economic development, integra-
8 tion, general welfare and related matters.

9 Said commission may call upon officials of the common-
10 wealth or its various agencies and subdivisions and may also
11 call upon officials of the federal government and its various
12 agencies and departments for information and assistance as it
13 may require in the course of its investigation and study.

14 Said commission may travel within and without the com-
15 monwealth.

16 Said commission may, subject to appropriation, hire staff
17 and consultants to assist it in its investigation and study and
18 in making its recommendations.

19 Said commission shall report to the general court the re-
20 sults of its investigation and study and its recommendations,
21 if any, by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or
22 before the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred
23 and eighty-four.
