AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF GREAT BARRINGTON TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO JOSEPH DOMANEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen
2 of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General
3 Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Great Barring-
4 ton is hereby authorized to issue a license for the sale of all
5 alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under
6 the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred
7 and thirty-eight to Joseph Domaney d/b/a Domaney's Pack-
8 age Store. Said license shall be subject to all the provisions
9 of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except section
10 seventeen; provided however, that the number of seasonal li-
11 censes for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk
12 on the premises authorized for said town to grant under the
13 provisions of said section seventeen of said chapter one hun-
14 dred and thirty-eight shall be reduced by one such license;
15 and provided further that said licensing authority shall not
16 approve the transfer of said license within one year after the
17 date of issuance by said licensing authority.
