AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF HANDICAPPED AFFAIRS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 185 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as inserted
2 by section 289 of chapter 351 of the Acts of 1981, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the fourth sentence and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence: —

5 The position of director shall be classified in accordance
6 with section forty-five of chapter thirty, and the salary shall
7 be determined in accordance with section forty-six C of said
8 chapter thirty, and such director shall devote his full time
9 during business hours to the duties of the office.
