**AN ACT TO AMEND THE BAY STATE SKILLS ACT TO ALLOW  
LICENSED CAREER SCHOOLS TO PARTICIPATE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section four of chapter 40I of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 44 of the acts of 1982, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the definition of  
4 "Educational Institution" and inserting in place thereof the  
5 following:-  
6 "Educational Institution," a public secondary or post-  
7 secondary institution, propriety trade, business, vocational,  
8 technical, professional or correspondence school licensed by  
9 the department of education according to Chapter 75C,  
10 Chapter 75D and Chapter 93 of the Massachusetts General  
11 Laws, as so appearing, or an independent non-profit in-  
12 stitution within the commonwealth authorized by law to  
13 provide a program of skills, training or education beyond the  
14 secondary school level.
