**AN ACT PROVIDING COST-OF-LIVING INCREASES TO
PERSONS RECEIVING CERTAIN WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34A of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 6 of chapter 474 of the acts of
3 1976, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 paragraph:-

5 In addition to other payments required under the
6 provisions of this section, the insurer shall also pay to such
7 injured employee, after such employee has been so in-
8 capacitated for a period longer than six months, an amount,
9 as determined by the division, to compensate for increases in
10 cost-of-living, so-called.
