AN ACT MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO ESTABLISH A RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORP (R.O.T.C.) FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Congress of the United States shall establish and pay for
- 2 with federal funds a Reserve Officers Training Corp (R.O.T.C.)
- 3 for students in high schools, including regional and district
- 4 high schools.
- 5 Students, upon being commissioned to the rank of Second
- 6 Lieutenant, Ensign, or equal rank shall be required, after ac-
- 7 cepting said commission, to serve five consecutive years in the
- 8 reserves, with a 30 to 45 day tour of duty a year.
