AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 138 of the General Laws as amended by  
2 Chapter 542 of the acts of 1943 is hereby further amended by  
3 striking the second sentence thereof and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following sentence: "No Alcoholic beverage which  
5 has been damaged by fire or other casualty may be offered  
6 for sale in the Commonwealth and shall be destroyed by the  
7 owner on such terms and conditions as the Commonwealth  
8 shall determine."
