**AN ACT GRANTING JUVENILE COURT JUDGES AUTHORITY TO POSTPONE APPLICATION BY JUVENILE OFFENDERS FOR DRIVER'S LICENSES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 58 of chapter 119 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 533 of the  
3 acts of 1976, is hereby further amended by adding the follow-  
4 ing sentence: — Said probation may also include a require-  
5 ment that a child who is adjudged a delinquent child refrain  
6 from applying for any license to operate motor vehicles for a  
7 period of time specified by the court.
