AN ACT FOR LEGISLATION RELATIVE TO THE SERVICE OF CAPIAS
IN CONTEMPT ACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 34A of Chapter 215 of the General Laws as most re-
- 2 cently amended by Chapter 282 of the Acts of 1982 is hereby
- 3 amended by adding, in the second paragraph, after the words
- 4 "deputy sheriff" in the fourth line the following: "constable,
- 5 or upon motion any person designated by the court to make
- 6 such service."
