RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION FOR A JUVENILE PROBATION SYSTEM.

- 1 *Resolved*, there shall be established a commission to study
- 2 the need, feasibility and cost analysis of developing a statewide
- 3 juvenile probation system.
- 4 Such commission shall consist of five members of the House
- 5 of Representatives appointed by the Speaker; three members
- 6 of the Senate appointed by the President; the Chief Ad-
- 7 ministrative Judge of the juvenile court, the Commissioner of
- 8 the department of youth services, the commissioner of the
- 9 department of social services, the commissioner of the depart-
- 10 ment of mental health and eight members appointed by the
- 11 Governor including but not limited to probation, police officers,
- 12 attorneys, parents, parole officers and adolescents.
