AN ACT ESTABLISHING MAY TWENTY-NINTH AS A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Clause Eighteenth of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: —
