AN ACT PERMITTING A CITY OR TOWN TO APPROPRIATE MONEY ANNUALLY FOR COMMEMORATION OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH AND ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF ITS SETTLEMENT OR OF ITS INCORPORATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (27B) of section 5 of chapter 40 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 20 of the acts of 1980, is hereby
3 amended by striking the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: —

5 For the celebration of the one hundredth, one hundred and
6 fiftieth, two hundredth, two hundred and fiftieth, three hun-
7 dredth and three hundred and fiftieth anniversary of its set-
8 tlement or of its incorporation, any city or town may appro-
9 priate money annually during the five years preceding such
10 anniversary.
