**AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING FOREST CUTTING PRACTICES
WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 42 of Chapter 132 of the General Laws as most recent-
- 2 ly amended by Chapter 592 of the Acts of 1983 is hereby amend-
- 3 ed by striking the words "ten days" wherever they appear and
- 4 substituting thereof the words "five days."
