SENATE No. 1326

By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1326) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to permit the Division of Water Pollution Control to issue regulations to limit the percentage of chemicals that may be used in products sold within the Commonwealth. AN ACT PERMITTING THE DIVISION OF WATER POLLUTION CONTROL TO ISSUE REGULATIONS LIMITING THE PERCENTAGE OF CHEMICALS THAT MAY BE USED IN PRODUCTS SOLD WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Clause (8) of section 27 of Chapter 21 of the General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended by adding after the first sentence the fol-
- 3 lowing: —
- 4 In addition, the division may adopt rules and regulations
- 5 limiting the percentage of various chemicals that may be con-
- 6 tained in soaps and detergents or other products sold within
- 7 the commonwealth which may pass in normal use into the in-
- 8 dustrial or municipal sewerage systems for residences, com-
- 9 mercial or industrial establishments, and through such pas-
- 10 sage affect the cost of treatment or the quality of water where
- 11 finally discharged from such system.
