AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE USE OF HEADLIGHTS ON
MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recent-
2 ly amended by chapter 71 of the acts of 1964, is hereby further
3 amended by adding after the first paragraph the following
4 paragraph: —

5 Every person operating a vehicle on a public way shall have
6 lights which shall be displayed as to be visible from the front
7 and the rear during any period in which rain, snow, sleet, mist,
8 fog or any precipitation shall be falling in a quantity whereby
9 windshield wipers are needed to give clear visibility.
