By Mr. Doris, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1402) of Francis D. Doris for legislation to provide police powers for the Bureau of Special Investigations. Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING POLICE POWERS FOR THE BUREAU OF SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 30R of chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 The secretary may, at the request of the director of the
- 4 bureau of special investigations, appoint a special police of-
- 5 ficers employees of said division. Such special police officers
- 6 shall serve for one year, subject to removal by the secretary,
- 7 and they shall have the same power to make arrests as the
- 8 state police and shall have the power to serve warrants and
- 9 other criminal processes. They shall report to the commis-
- 10 sioner as to their pay, except their regular compensation as
- 11 employees of said division, and they shall receive no fees for
- 12 service or return of any criminal process.
