By Mr. McKenna, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1417) of Denis L. McKenna for legislation relative to motor vehicle license and registration fees for individuals age sixty-five or older. Public Safety.

**AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE AND REGISTRATION
FEES FOR INDIVIDUALS AGE SIXTY-FIVE OR OLDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenth paragraph of subsection 7 of section
2 33 of chapter 90 is hereby amended by adding the following
3 sentence: — For every license of an individual age sixty-five
4 or older to operate motor vehicles or the renewal thereof, the
5 fee shall not be more than ten dollars.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 33 of said chapter 90 is hereby
2 amended by adding the following: — For the registration of
3 a motor vehicle by an individual age sixty-five or older, the
4 fee shall not be more than seven dollars; and for the issuance
5 in connection with the registration of any motor vehicle, at the
6 request of the applicant of a distinctive initial plate, ten
7 dollars; or of a particular number plate other than a distinc-
8 tive initial plate, two dollars.
