**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A STICKER FOR TEMPORARY
USE BY CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 2, the following section: —

3 *Section 2A.* The registrar may issue special stickers and cer-
4 tificates designed for use by persons suffering from a disability
5 or handicap of a non-permanent nature, such standards of
6 disability and handicap and of qualification for the issuance
7 of said stickers to be determined by said registrar as he deems
8 proper.
