By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1436) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to regulate the number plates of Metropolitan Police vehicles. Public Safety.

**AN ACT REGULATING THE NUMBER PLATES OF METROPOLITAN
POLICE VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Registrar of Motor Vehicles shall issue to the
- 2 Metropolitan District Commission distinctive number plates
- 3 that will be used for Metropolitan Police vehicles. Said number
- 4 plates, shall have a white background, with blue lettering; the
- 5 word: "Massachusetts" shall be on the lower portion of the
- 6 plate. The word: "METROPOLITAN" shall appear over the
- 7 word "POLICE" and both should appear in the right half of
- 8 the number plate to be followed by a series of one, two, or three
- 9 numerals, on the left half of the number plate.
