AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN PROTECTION FOR TAXICAB DRIVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 22 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as amended
- 2 by section 73A of chapter 329 of the acts of 1980, is hereby fur-
- 3 ther amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 Such rules and orders for the regulation of hackney vehicles
- 5 shall include provisions requiring that a bulletproof partition
- 6 be installed between the driver and the passenger and such
- 7 other rules and orders as the commissioner of public safety
- 8 may from time to time order for the protection of hackney
- 9 drivers.
