AN ACT TO INCLUDE AND AUTHORIZE JUSTICES OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO BE COMPENSATED FOR ACCRUED SICK LEAVE UPON RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 hereby amended by inserting the following after the words
3 "fifty E," in the second line thereof: — "or judges or justices
4 of the courts of the commonwealth."

1 SECTION 2. Section 56 of Chapter 699 of the Acts of 1981 is
2 further amended by inserting the following after the word
3 "employee" in the fifth line thereof: — "or judge or justice"

1 SECTION 3. Section 56 of Chapter 699 of the Acts of 1981 is
2 further amended by inserting the following after the word
3 "employee" at the end thereof: — "or judge or justice."
