AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EMPLOYEE REINSTATEMENT WHEN THE OPEN MEETING LAW IS VIOLATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23B of Chapter 39 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by Section 3 of Chapter 220 of the acts of
3 1980, is hereby further amended by adding the following sen-
4 tence to the twelfth paragraph: —

5 Such order may include reinstatement without loss of com-
6 pensation, seniority, tenure or other benefits.
