AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE METROPOLITAN STATE BUILDING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Medical and Surgical building at the Metropolitan State  
2 Hospital, located principally in the Town of Lexington, shall  
3 be designated and known as the "WILLIAM F. McLAUGH-  
4 LIN BUILDING" in honor of the former Superintendent of  
5 the Metropolitan State Hospital, William F. McLaughlin, who  
6 served the Commonwealth with dedication and compassion  
7 for many years.
