**AN ACT FOR LEGISLATION TO FURTHER REGULATE DEDUCTIONS
ALLOWABLE IN DETERMINING MASSACHUSETTS TAXABLE INCOME.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of subparagraph (8) of
2 paragraph (a) of subsection B of section 3 of chapter 62 of the
3 General Laws, as appearing in section 40 of chapter 684 of the
4 acts of 1975, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
5 "Code", in line 4, the words: — , or includes a disabled
6 dependent.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to taxable years commenc-
2 ing after December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and seventy-
3 five.
