By Mr. Wetmore, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1821) of Walter H. Shales and Robert D. Wetmore for legislation relative to waiving the requirement of filing an annual application for certain exemptions from the motor vehicle excises. Taxation.

AN ACT WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT OF FILING AN ANNUAL APPLICATION FOR CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as most re-
- 2 cently amended by Chapter 597 of the Acts of 1982, is hereby
- 3 further amended by striking out the last sentence in the sixth
- 4 paragraph and inserting in place thereof, the following: —
- 5 After the assessors have allowed an exemption under this
- 6 paragraph no further evidence of the existence of the facts
- 7 required by this paragraph shall be required, nor shall any fur-
- 8 ther application be required, in any subsequent year in the
- 9 city or town in which the exemption has been so allowed.
