AN ACT TO REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR COST INCURRED DUE
TO AN INCREASE IN TRAFFIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subsection G of section 3 of Chapter 161A of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by adding to the last sentence the
- 3 following:
- 4 provided further that any cost incurred by a city or town due
- 5 to increased traffic which is a direct result of new or expanded
- 6 off street parking facilities and access roads in or near that
- 7 city or town, shall be reimbursed from fees collected for the
- 8 use of that facility.
