**AN ACT REGULATING THE TRAFFIC UTILIZATION OF LAKE STREET IN  
THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No vehicle and appurtenant connected carriage  
2 having a cumulative total of six or more wheels shall be per-  
3 mitted to transverse any portion of Lake Street in the Town of  
4 Arlington.

1 SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation shall take the  
2 appropriate action to implement this enactment.
