**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-four.

AN ACT FOR LEGISLATION TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF PIER FIVE ALSO KNOWN AS COMMONWEALTH PIER, FOR HOTEL OR RESTAURANT PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regu-  
2 lation to the contrary, the Massachusetts Port Authority is  
3 hereby prohibited from constructing or from permitting the  
4 construction of any hotel or restaurant on Pier Five, also  
5 known as the Commonwealth Pier.
